The site of Octeville also called l'OTAN or Site of Bernard Lejard is in **DANGER**.

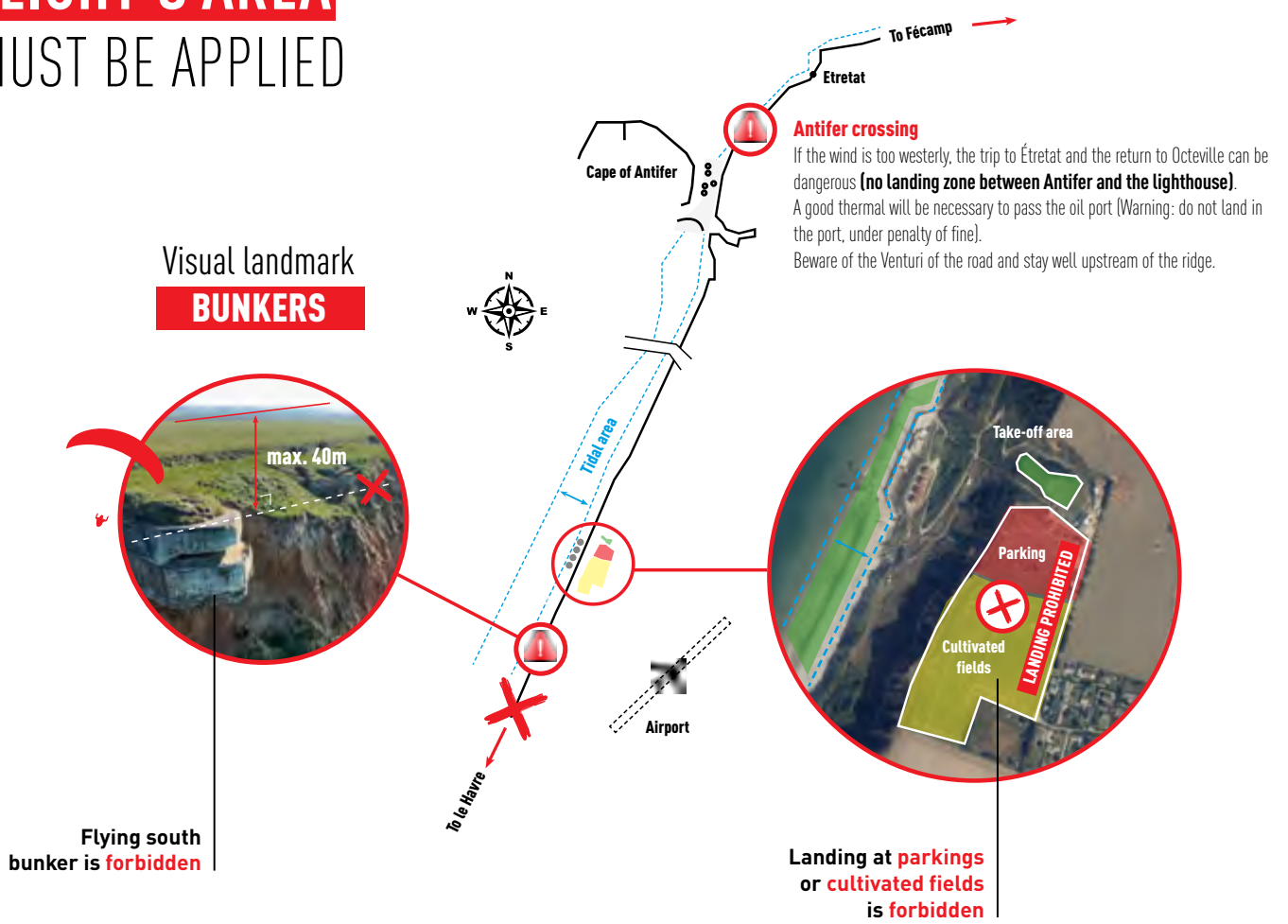
Too many incivilities from pilots who do not respect the rules of flight area, flight level and safety put our practice at risk.

THE CONTROL TOWER MUST CONTACT YOU AT ALL TIMES**

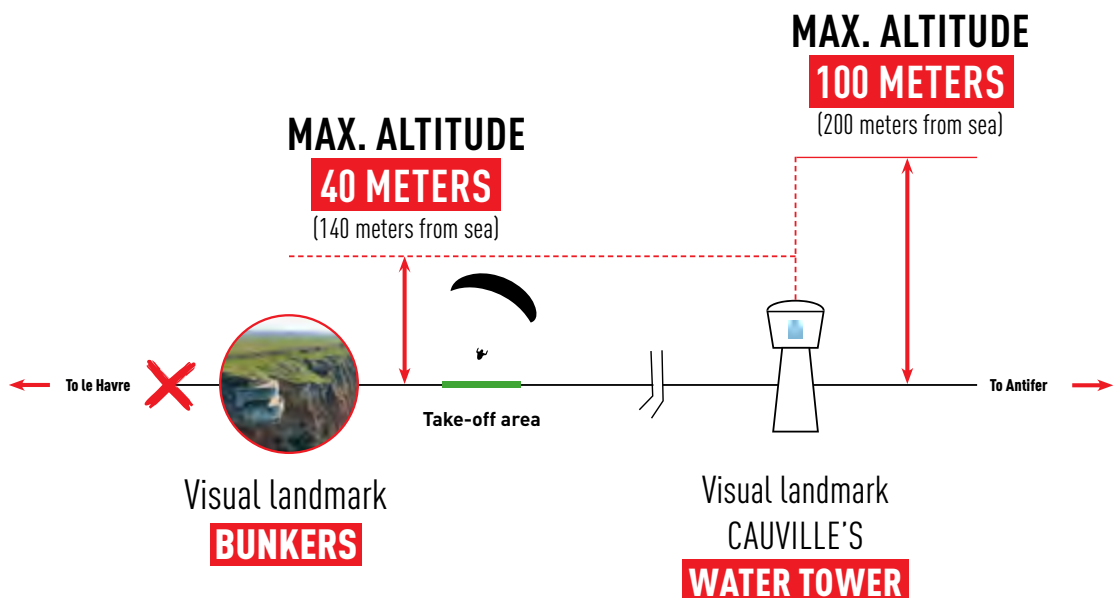

## FLIGHT'S LEVELS

The maximum authorised altitude is **40 meters above the cliffs** of the take-off zone and this for **8 kilometres** in the direction of Antifer up to the visual landmark of the Cauville water tower.

From the Cauville water tower, the maximum permitted altitude is increased to a maximum of 100 meters.

Keep in mind TMA Deauville is above us IFR point LH0346 in CTR.
